The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF World Cup is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day).

The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory, however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All Rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one (1) panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two (2) or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

Shotgun Equipment

All Skeet athletes must have an ISSF seal with serial number on their Skeet marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have an ISSF seal on the Skeet marker tape must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for Shotguns or Skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Buttstock Height (for Skeet only)

The height of the buttstock (either adjustable or "Monte Carlo" type) measured from the highest point of the cheek rest to the lowest point of the butt plate toe must not exceed 170mm (17cm). Any butt plate toe vertical extension which is not an integral part of the buttstock and simply intended to increase its height, is not permitted.

Cartridge Control

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g or less, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disgualified (DSQ).

During Final, all six (6) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Final and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 15 minutes before the start of the Final. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once cartridges are placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove cartridges from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Final (There will be no elimination for 6th place; the first elimination will be for 5th place).

Colored Wads

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used. Colored wads are prohibited.

Equipment Control

Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event who are competing for Medals. In addition, up to two (2) additional athletes per event can be entered to compete for Ranking Points Only (RPO).

Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

Maximum Entry / Range Capacity

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete / mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

ISSF and Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Attention: Starting from 2025, all athletes, even with an official ISSF ID number already issued, must sign the updated "Athlete's Declaration" (Edition 2025) once again. Without renewed signature the athlete cannot be registered online and will not be allowed to participate in any ISSF Championship. The ISSF Headquarters communicated all details about this new procedure already in November 2025.

ISSF Member Federations are urged to ensure that all of their athletes who should be registered for the ISSF World Cup Buenos Aires 2025 have signed the updated declaration and returned it together with the a copy of the athlete's passport for verification purposes to the ISSF Headquarters at registration@issf-sports.org far ahead of the Final Entry Deadline.

5. Registration Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1-6) and return them by the established deadlines (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email will not be accepted.

Preliminary Entries

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the **Late Entry Deadline** (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **28 MAR 2025**.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of status ("Medal" athlete ↔ "RPO" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **29 MAR 2025** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating ISSF Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From 29 MAR 2025 onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.
- b) Status exchange between a registered athlete for competing for Medals and a "RPO" athlete can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (2 MAR 2025) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athlete and official entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Entry Fees

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

The entry fees include one (1) round of Pre-Event Training for Shotgun.

They DO NOT include additional costs for Pre-Event and Unofficial/Official Training.

Payment of Entry Fees

All Entry Fees payments must be done to the Organizing Committee only.

Upon request ISSF Member Federations may receive an invoice according which they will be able to make bank transfer. We kindly ask these federations (which will prefer to send money through bank transfer) to make all payments not later than **1 MAR 2025**. All amounts must be paid in **EUR or USD** and must include any transfer fees or similar fees that the bank may charge. The exchange rate between **EUR and USD** will be provided at the time of issuing the corresponding invoice. Take care that all necessary data is transferred, so that the Organizing Committee can assign payments to the correct federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your Team Leader to bring with him / her to the Entry Confirmation.

All payments which will be done upon arrival to the Organizing Committee must be paid only in cash in **EUR or USD** according the official exchange rate. (No travel checks or credit cards will be accepted).

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline) will be prepared in advance by the ISSF and Organizing Committee. During the online registration process, the ISSF Member Federations can upload pictures of their athletes and officials to be displayed on the accreditations. **There will be no possibility to take photos for accreditations on the shooting range.**Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

6. Shooting Range

The ISSF World Cup will take place at the "Tiro Federal Argentino de Buenos Aires" shooting range. The range is situated at a 15 minutes driving distance from the city center and 44 km from the Ministro

Pistarini International Airport (EZE).

Rifle/Pistol

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

Range Description

10m range 60 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG

25m range 40 firing points (8 groups); electronic targets, SIUS AG

50m hall 60 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG

The firing direction of the 25m and 50m range is south.

Shotgun

The shooting range has four (4) combined ranges for Trap/Skeet.

The shooting range is equipped with Laporte (Tokyo model) machines and Elettronica Progetti acoustic release system.

The Skeet ranges operate with acoustic release system.

All ranges are equipped with Elettronica Progetti electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is south.

The targets used for the ISSF World Cup are eco-friendly from Laporte (Grand Prix 24), standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Visa

We strongly advise all ISSF Member Federations to verify well in advance whether they need a visa for entry into Argentina Republic. Detailed and last updated information regarding visas and formalities for entry into Argentina Republic can be found on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, International Trade and Worship of the Argentine Republic https://cancilleria.gob.ar/en/services/visa/tourist-visa

Fortunately for foreign travelers, Argentina has a visa policy that allows citizens of more than 120 nationalities to enter without having to apply for a tourist visa.

In this article, we will provide detailed information on which countries need a visa to enter Argentina and how to obtain it, as well as which countries are exempt from this requirement.

It is important to note that, regardless of whether you need a visa or not to enter Argentina, other documents may be required, such as a valid passport, proof of sufficient funds, and a confirmed travel itinerary.

Participants must fill and send the **Visa Support Form (Annex 5) as early as possible, but not later than 1 FEB 2025** in order to receive the nominative invitation letter which can help to obtain the visa. This form must be sent in **WORD** format only.

All nations that need an official invitation from the Federacion Argentina de Tiro, must request it before **1 FEB 2025** (Annex 5). Please send an email to the Federacion Argentina de Tiro, requesting it.



VISA TO TRAVEL TO ARGENTINA: COUNTRIES THAT NEED TO APPLY

For some countries it is necessary to obtain a visa before traveling to Argentina. ARGENTINA VISA: HOW TO OBTAIN IT FOR TOURISM ENTRY

If you need to apply for visa, the first step is to contact the Argentine embassy or consulate in your home country. There, you will be provided with detailed information on the required documents, forms to complete, and processing times. It is important to start this process well in advance to avoid any delays in your journey.

If it turns out that you do need to obtain a visa as a foreign tourist from a country with which the Argentine Republic does not have a visa exemption agreement, here are the details on how to do so: https://cancilleria.gob.ar/en/services

You should know that a tourist is considered to be a foreigner who enters the country for the purpose of rest / recreation, with an authorized stay of up to three (3) months, extendable for another similar period.

Important:

The Organizing Committee has no influence to State Migration Service or Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and arriving to Argentina without visa may cause deportation.

GUN LICENSE

All athletes must declare all the firearms (including 4.5 / .177 caliber) and ammunition to be brought into Argentina and return to the Federacion Argentina de Tiro the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) no later than **1 MAR 2025**.

The Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) will be accepted in **WORD** format only. No handwriting or fax transmission will be accepted.

The cost for firearm and ammunition permit is **EUR** 10**0.00** per athlete.

The Organizing Committee will provide assistance with customs formalities upon arrival. Customs authorities will allow all participating athletes to import with them a maximum of 500 rounds of ammunition to be used for the competition.

It is mandatory by law that all firearms, including compressed air guns, must be declared, as well as their ammunitions (12ga, .22Lr & 4.5mm)

Important:

Firearms and Ammunition must go directly to the armory at the shooting range. No type of firearms, including air guns, may be taken to the hotel or outside the shooting range.

8. Accommodation

All ISSF Member Federations are kindly requested to complete appropriate Final Hotel Reservation Form (Annex 2) and return it to the Organizing Committee no later than **1 FEB 2025**.

Final Hotel Reservation Form (Annex 2) will be accepted in **WORD** format only and the reservation will be managed on a "first come – first serve" basis. The Organizing Committee will send confirmation to each delegation with the name and address of the hotel you will stay at. Each federation will receive company invoice and agreement, according which you will be able to make bank transfer. We kindly ask federations to make all payments not later than **2025**. Payment within the deadline is absolutely required.

All amounts must be paid in **EUR or USD** and must include any transfer fees or similar fees that the bank may charge. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your Team Leader to bring with him / her.

In case of cancellation after **1 FEB 2025** and/or a no-show, hotels will charge a cancellation fee of 100% of the costs for all nights and rooms you have booked.

9. Travel and Transportation

All participating ISSF Member Federations are required to bring with them their national flag (minimum size: 1m x 1.5m approximately) and one (1) national anthem on standard CD or USB.
