### 3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Championship will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website [www.issf-sports.org](http://www.issf-sports.org).

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Championship. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

#### Equipment Control

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

## 4. Participation

### Individual Events / Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event who may participate as one (1) team in team event.

### Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

### Maximum Entry / Range Capacity

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete/mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a “waiting list” for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

ISSF and Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

### ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Championship.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

### Juniors

Athletes will remain as Juniors until the 31st December of the year in which they become 21 years of age. Therefore, for the ISSF World Championship Tallinn 2026 athletes must be born in 2005 or later.

## Minimum Participation Requirements

The minimum participation requirements for official ISSF World Championship events, so with official Championship medals and the opportunity to set official ISSF World Records, are as following:

- Individual Events            15 Athletes for Senior Events / 10 Athletes for Junior Events
- Team Events                    5 Teams
- Mixed Team Events        10 Mixed Teams

If an event does not reach the minimum requirement at the Final Entry Deadline, the federations with entries in this event will be notified.

If an event does not reach the minimum requirement at the Late Entry Deadline, it will be declared an “International Championship of Estonia”.

## 5. Registration Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 2 – 6) and return them by the established deadlines (see also: “Summary of Deadlines”).

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Forms available, any entries received by email will not be accepted.

### Preliminary Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <https://shootingsportscloud.com>.  
The Preliminary Entry Deadline is **20 APR 2026**.

### Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must submit their Final Entries by using the ISSF Online Registration System at <https://shootingsportscloud.com>.  
The **Final Entry Deadline** (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is **20 JUN 2026**.

### Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the **Late Entry Deadline** (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **16 JUL 2026**.

**Important Note:** Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the change of names / athletes within an event in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **17 JUL 2026** onwards, may not participate.

### Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating ISSF Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

### Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **17 JUL 2026** onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) is permitted and can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

## Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (**20 JUN 2026**) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athlete and official entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

## Entry Fees

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

The entry fees include one (1) round of Pre-Event Training.

They DO NOT include additional costs for Pre-Event and Unofficial Training.

**No credit cards, traveler check or cash payments on arrival.**

## Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Championship (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline) will be prepared in advance by the ISSF and Organizing Committee. During the online registration process, the ISSF Member Federations can upload pictures of their athletes and officials to be displayed on the accreditations.

**There will be no possibility to take photos for accreditations on the shooting range.**

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

## 6. Shooting Range

The ISSF World Championship will take place at the Männiku shooting range in Tallinn, Estonia.

### Moving Target

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

Range	Description
10m range	4 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
50m range	2 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG

The firing direction of the 50m range is South-East.

## 7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

### Entry Visa

Estonia is a member of the European Union and the **Schengen Area**.

EU nationals may enter Estonia with a valid passport or a valid national identity card.

Participants from countries requiring an **Entry Visa** for Estonia should apply to the Estonian Embassy or Consulate in their country of residence well in advance of departure. Detailed information regarding visa requirements can be found on the website of the **Estonian Ministry of Foreign Affairs**: <https://www.vm.ee/en/consular-visa-and-travel-information/visa-information/application-schengen-visa>.

Federations requiring a specific **Invitation Letter** to apply for a Visa must contact the Organising Committee no later than **1 JUL 2026** via email: [info@laskurliit.ee](mailto:info@laskurliit.ee) by sending following information:

1. Full name as in passport
2. Function in the team
3. Passport number
4. Passport expiry date
5. Copy of Passport (Clear to see)

**Please note** that for some countries, this deadline **may be too late** to allow sufficient time for visa applications.

**Visas Will Not be granted upon arrival at the airport.**

### Custom Formalities, Import of Firearms, Firearm License

Upon entering Estonia, you must present an invitation letter and declare all firearms to the police at the border. You will be required to present an official firearms owner's certificate.

- **EU Firearms Pass Holders:** Participants with a valid EU Firearms Pass simply need to present it to the police officer. No additional forms or taxes are required.

- **Non-EU Participants (or those without an EU Firearms Pass):** Non-EU Participants need to apply for a temporary firearm permit. In this case send Firearm and Ammunition Form, passport copies and national gun permit copies by email to [info@laskurliit.ee](mailto:info@laskurliit.ee) no later than **1 JUN 2026**

**Upon Arrival** in Estonia, all firearms and ammunition must be transported directly to the **armoury** at the shooting range.

**For Departure**, firearms and ammunition must be collected from the **Armoury** only when travelling directly to the airport.

## 8. Accommodation

### Official Hotels

Accommodation is offered at the following prices, per room per night, including breakfast and tax.

The amount of accommodation invoice must be paid by the Final Payment Deadline **15 JUL 2026**. Although the booking will be based on the principle “first come, first served” teams making the reservation sooner.

Final Rooming List (Annex 3) must be submitted by: **20 JUN 2026**.

### Food Service at the Shooting Range

There will be a food truck available at the shooting range.

## 9. Travel and Transportation

### Travel – Arrival

Arrival and Departure Transportation Service (airport – hotel – airport) will be provided on the designated Official Arrival and Departure Days (20 JUL 2026 and 26 JUL 2026) only.

### Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)

Transportation fee from Tallinn Airport to the hotels and from hotels to the Tallinn Airport is **25 EUR**.

### Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

There will be shuttle service twice per day from the hotels to the shooting range at 07:00 and 08:30. From the shooting range back to hotels there will be shuttles at 2 different times, according to schedule.

## 10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

### Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on 21 JUL 2026 at the shooting range.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Championship.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

### Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

Armoury (**Firearm Storage**) is located at the shooting range, open daily from 07:15 am until 30 minutes after the end of the last competition.

### Ammunition

There will be no ammunition sales available at the venue.

### Doping Control Tests

Doping Controls Tests will be conducted in accordance with the actual ISSF Anti-Doping Rules.

## 11. Ceremonies

### Opening and Closing Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on 21 JUL 2026 at the shooting range.

The Closing Ceremony will take place on 25 JUL 2026 at the shooting range.

### Medal Ceremony

The Medal Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range immediately after the end of each competition (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

### Flags and Anthems

All participating federations are required to bring with them at least one (1) of their national flags (1mx1.5m approximately) and one (1) national anthem on standard CD or USB stick (40 – 50 sec).
