 A shuttle bus service will operate between the airport and the official hotel.

▪ **Shooting competition:**

Trap (Men's & Women's): 125 Target + Final

Skeet (Men's & Women's): 125 Target + Final

*Team events will be judged by the total score of each team of 3 members; there will be no team competition.

*If the number of female participants does not reach a certain number, the competition will be held as a mixed-gender event.

▪ **Rules and Regulations:**

This will be in accordance with ISSF regulations. It will not be reflected in ISSF competition results.

▪ **Entry and Participation:**

To ensure smooth competition, this tournament will be limited to 60 participants in the trap shooting event and 24 participants in the skeet shooting event. If the number of entries exceeds these limits, we may ask each participating country to adjust their entry numbers. Thank you for your understanding.

Each participating country can select three players for a team event, and there can be multiple teams.

▪ **Tournament entry fee (per person):**

Athlete: ¥60,000-

Others: ¥45,000-

*These fees include registration, firearms management, transportation, lunch at the shooting range (3 days), and party expenses.

*These rates include breakfast, taxes, and service charges. Payment will be made directly to the hotel by the participating federation or representative upon check-in. Any additional services or personal charges must be paid before check-out.

*The cancellation deadline is October 1, 2026, at 12:00 a.m. (Japan Standard Time) Cancellations or no-shows after this time will incur a 100% cancellation fee.

▪ **Registration and Payment:**

All participating teams must confirm their final entry and transfer the tournament fee in Japanese Yen (JPY) to the bank account listed below by July 25, 2026. Transfers in US dollars or other currencies will not be accepted.

▪ **Meal:**

Lunch will be served at the shooting range.

Dinner is not included and is at your own expense.

There are various restaurants within the hotel and in the surrounding area.

▪ **Transportation:**

A shuttle bus service operates between the airport and the official hotel (approximately 60

minutes).

A shuttle bus service operates between the shooting range and the official hotel (approximately 40 minutes).

- **Firearms and ammunition:**

Participating teams are required to declare all firearms and ammunition. Please complete the application form and submit it to the organizing committee by **July 25, 2026**.

Bringing ammunition into Japan is prohibited.

Firearms and ammunition will be stored at a Shooting range during your stay in Japan. Taking them out is prohibited. Ammunition can be purchased at the shooting range.

***Regarding leftover ammunition**

All ammunition used during the competition must be used up within the competition period. Due to Japanese law prohibiting the possession of ammunition for purposes other than its intended use, any remaining ammunition must be disposed of at the shooting range. Ammunition can be purchased at the shooting range, so please plan and order the required quantity in advance. (Additional purchases are also possible.)

Ammunition (for both skeet and trap): 25 rounds per box, ¥2,500

Facility fee: ¥1,250 + Practice fee (per round): ¥1,550

*Due to recent global changes, price increases are possible until November.

Please be aware of the price increase for the tournament in November.

In accordance with the strict security regulations of the Japanese government, the procedures for handling firearms and ammunition are as follows:

- 1) Upon arrival at Narita International Airport, firearms will be removed from personal possession after passing through customs and will be stored at the shooting range. Note: Bringing ammunition is prohibited.
- 2) During your stay in Japan, you are not permitted to take firearms or ammunition out of the shooting range.
- 3) Upon departure from Japan, firearms will be transported to the airport and handed over to your respective team at the airport.

- **Entry and customs procedures:**

To ensure a smooth immigration and customs declaration process upon arrival in Japan, we recommend registering with "Visit Japan Web" beforehand.

Please save the QR code issued after registration to your smartphone or print it out and bring it with you.

- For those from countries requiring a visa: Please obtain your visa in advance from the Japanese embassy. If you require a letter of invitation, please contact us as soon as possible.
- For those from visa-exempt countries: Your country may be eligible for the JESTA pre-authorization system, which will be introduced in 2026. Please check the latest requirements yourself before departure and complete the application if necessary.

*Please note that information regarding entry into the country and customs procedures may be updated, so please refer to the latest information.

- **Ceremony:**

Opening Ceremony: Nov. 6, 2026 (Held at the hotel venue)

Awards & Closing Ceremony: Nov. 8, 2026 (Held at the shooting range)

Farewell Party: Nov. 8, 2026 (Held at the hotel venue)

Please wear your country's official uniform or national team uniform at the opening and closing ceremonies.

- **Climate:**

Temperatures will range from 8° C to 18° C. When it's sunny, the weather will be warm and pleasant for activities, but it will get cold quickly after sunset. We recommend bringing warm clothing.
